LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM STAGE 1 – 6

Canskate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program that focuses on agility, balance, and control in preparation for figure skating, hockey, and ringette. Six levels of badges and other incentives are awarded as fundamental skating skills are learned. Lessons are given in a group format and led by NCCP Certified Professional Coaches using teaching aids, music, and activities that create a fun, fast paced environment and promote learning. Coaches are assisted by trained Program Assistants. Warm mitts, coats and pants suggested. CSA certified Hockey Helmets are mandatory for Pre-CanSkate and CanSkate. (Cage optional) Private Lessons are available for all skaters, see information on website.

Pre-CanSkate (ages 3-5) is geared toward younger children with little to no skating experience. Children are introduced to basic skating through action songs, games and play and then progress into an informal group structure. Parents do not accompany their children on the ice. Children need to be able to stand and walk on their own in their skates on the floor - leave on the ice to us!

SYNCHRONIZED SKATING TEAM \$400

Join the Dorchester Dragonflies Synchro team and learn challenging skating skills and team co-operation in this fun discipline. Skaters who have passed Canskate Stage 4 and up are welcome to join Synchro! The objective is for the team to perform as one unit executing circles, blocks, lines, wheels and intersections in unison to music, while demonstrating quality edges, power and flow. Skaters will compete in competitions and perform in exhibitions. Team spirit wear and competition/travel expenses extra. Skaters must be enrolled in one other skating program with N.D.S.C. or other club to participate in this program. Teams will be determined by Sept 25.

PRELIMINARY (CANSKATE STAGE 5,6 - STARSKATE 1-4)

The next step after CANSKATE: For those skaters who have completed level 4 of the Canskate program and also for those who wish to learn more figure skating in a group lesson environment. Skaters will work on completing Canskate badges and learning Preliminary Dances, Free skate moves and skating Skills in the STARSKATE program. As this is a jam-packed program, we encourage skaters to skate both Monday and Thursday to maximize learning. There is a special rate for those who choose to skate both days Skate Canada Helmet policy will apply for all skaters Stage 5 and under. Private lessons are available and skaters will have the opportunity to work on their own..

The North Dorchester Skating Club is a non-profit organization run by volunteers and relies on fundraising to help subsidize seasonal operational costs. It is expected and necessary that each member (parent) help in some capacity during the year.

The Club's main form of fundraising is bingo. Bingos require 6 to 7 volunteers to make it run effectively, or we risk the chance of losing our license. Bingos are a very easy and fun way to work off your bond and usually take about 4 hours (1 credit). Time flies by very quickly and the bingo hall is a smoke-free environment. **Bingo volunteers must be 18 years of age or older. There will be sign up sheets at registration for your convenience.**
